It is recommended that you take photocopies of your important documents and keep in a separate place.

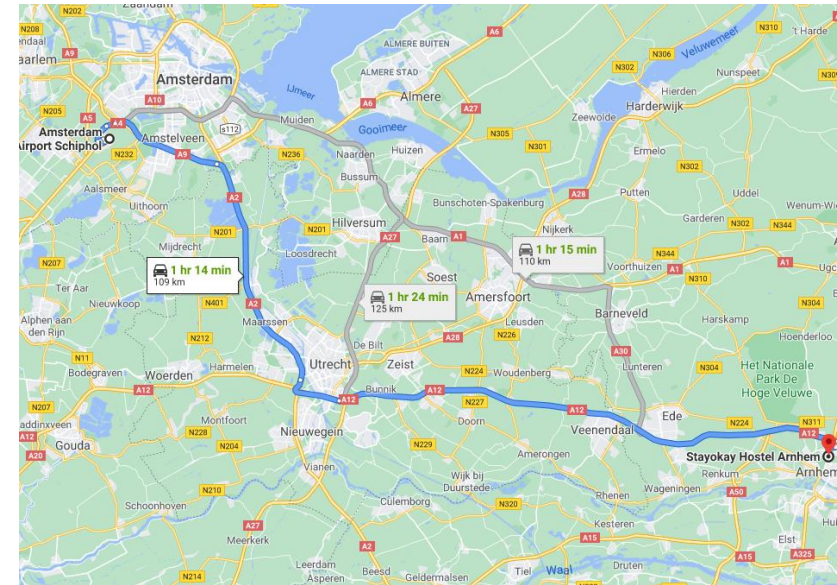
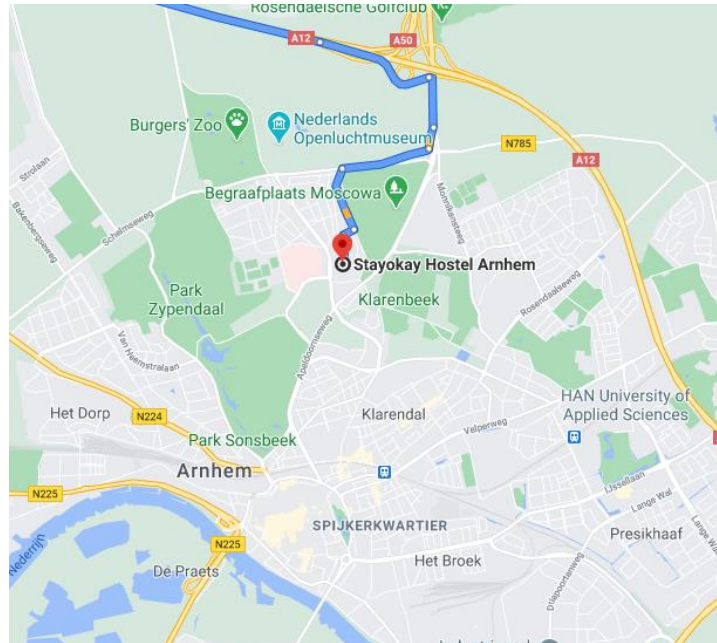

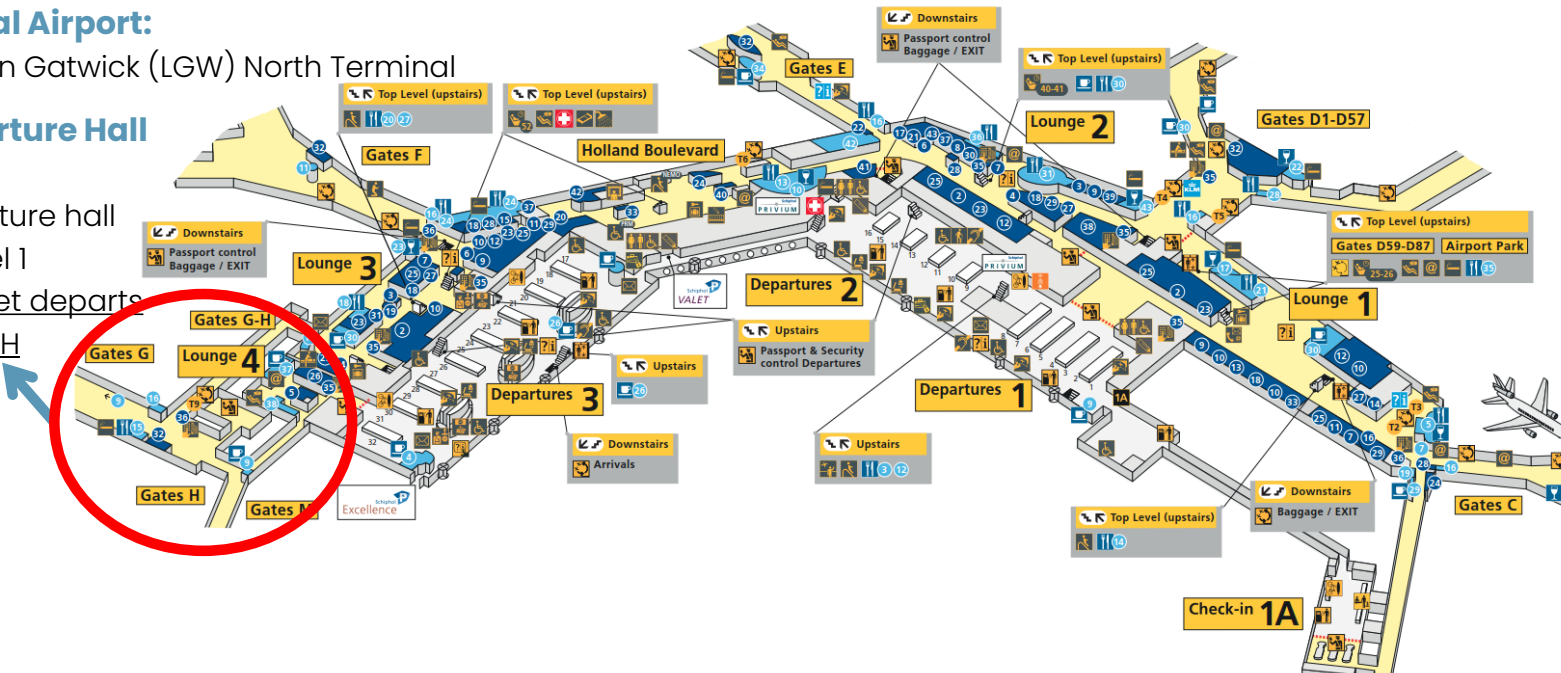

You will be able to travel to countries in the Schengen area [Netherlands] for up to 90 days in any 180-day period without a visa as a tourist, to visit family or friends, to attend business meetings, cultural or sports events, or for short-term studies or training.*
