- 20:30 Flight arrival London Gatwick Airport.
















ARRIVAL



Brexit

For a trip of this nature, there are **no additional steps** you must take for entry to the Netherlands after Brexit on 31st December 2020. You do not require a visa as a tourist.

<u>From the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office:</u> You will be able to travel to countries in the Schengen area [Netherlands] for up to 90 days in any 180-day period without a visa as a tourist, to visit family or friends, to attend business meetings, cultural or sports events, or for short-term studies or training.

Your passport needs to be valid for at least 30 days beyond your intended stay and have at least two blank pages.
