Zulu Land: Wildlife, Veterinary & Adventure

Our academic tea, veterinarians and qualified rangers at the Zulu Land Conservation Project offer a bespoke course to each institution dependent on the level of study.

We set out the basis of the trip to focus on wildlife conservation and research work, whilst linking the important role that a Wildlife Veterinarian plays in overall management of a game reserve. You will also gain understanding of rural community veterinary issues.



A full 9-hour day will be planned but will vary from day to day depending on the days task and research goals.

Project split and duration are as follows:

12 Day Itinerary

Days 1 – 8

Nambiti Big 5 Game Reserve. Conservation & Research activities including access to local wildlife veterinarian.

Days 9 – 12

Zingela Wilderness Reserve. Adventurous Expedition; hiking and river safari. Including access to local community veterinarian.

AFRICA

What is a Game Reserve?

- A game reserve is a large area of protected land where wild animals can live safely.
- Wildlife is free roaming throughout the reserve allowing them to thrive in their natural habitat.
- Reserves are either Government Owned (National Parks) or Privately Owned/Managed.
- Most reserves will have physical boundaries i.e. electrified fence line.
- Due to physical boundaries, wildlife must be managed due to restraints on population growth, migration and resources.
- Wildlife is protected but also utilised as a tourist attraction (Eco Tourism) which creates funding for conservation efforts and research.

AFRICA

Research – Habitat and Prey Selection: Predators

Focus on Lion and Cheetah populations:

GPS coordinates from tracking collars

Can be used for movement/spatial/home range analysis

ID kits available or can be created

Information available about management interventions (population changes, contraception etc)



Wildlife Monitoring – Elephant Impact Assessment

Research into impact of elephant on the eco system:

Matriarch collared so GPS range data available

Herd population data

Elephant impact assessments from February '23

Long term ongoing project looking at elephant impact on vegetation

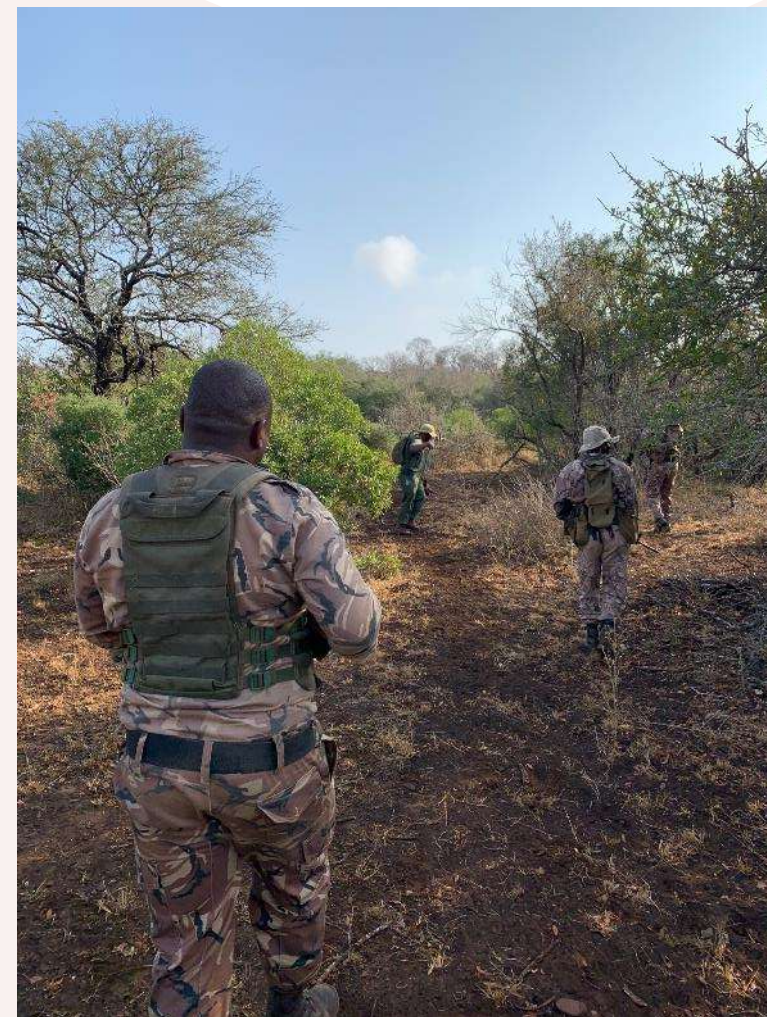
No current/previous data but there will be access to all ongoing

Community Projects

Group will work alongside the state vet and local NGOs across 3 vital community projects:

Rabies Vaccination Campaign

Students will travel in convoy to various community locations to administer rabies vaccinations to cats and dogs.

Dip tank visit & cattle vaccinations

Students will be given a revision on animal handling and record taking then assist with vaccinating livestock as well as any other basic animal health care that is required.

PAHC clinic visit

Students will assist with vaccinations and basic animal health care at the clinic and may have the opportunity to observe surgical procedures.
