- Education elements and content relevant to your study group.








Itinerary Map



- Stay in Arnhem, Netherlands. A city set in green surroundings, with the Veluwe National Park to one side and the forelands to Germany on the other.
- Apenheul Primate Park with free roaming primates.
- Royal Burgers Zoo in Arnhem with countless land based animals, plus the largest indoor mangrove in the world.
- Rotterdam, home to the Rotterdam Zoo, with walk through aquarium, completes the last full day of the programme.
- Overnight crossing from Hull to Rotterdam, aboard the Ferry.

Meet the keepers for educational tour, plus question and answer session.





Hull to Rotterdam Ferry

Sail away into the night when you get the ferry to Holland on one the crossing from Hull to Rotterdam.

There's so much on board for you to enjoy as you journey across the North Sea, from a choice of comfortable cabins to discount shopping and a whole range of different entertainment options on offer, this is sure to be one ferry crossing you won't forget and a great start to the trip!

Shared 4 person cabins are provided on the overnight ferry. Breakfasts and dinner are included for outbound and return.

Private rooms of four to six people for your group in hostel accommodation. Each room has an en-suite bathroom.

The hostel has it's own restaurant, plus a pub with an outside terrace. Communal spaces are recently updated and modern

It's located on the edge of the Veluwe National Park, and well situated for extra activities, like the Netherlands Open-Air Museum and just a fifteen minute bus rid to the city centre. Arnhem also has a deep history, known for the WWII battle of Arnhem, with famous landmarks and monuments dedicated to the battle.

Visits, activities or tours in Veluew National Park, Netherlands Open-Air Museum or the city centre can be organised, if requested.

Three meals a day will be provided from when you arrive in the Netherlands. From the first night's dinner, to breakfasts at your accommodation and packed lunches.
