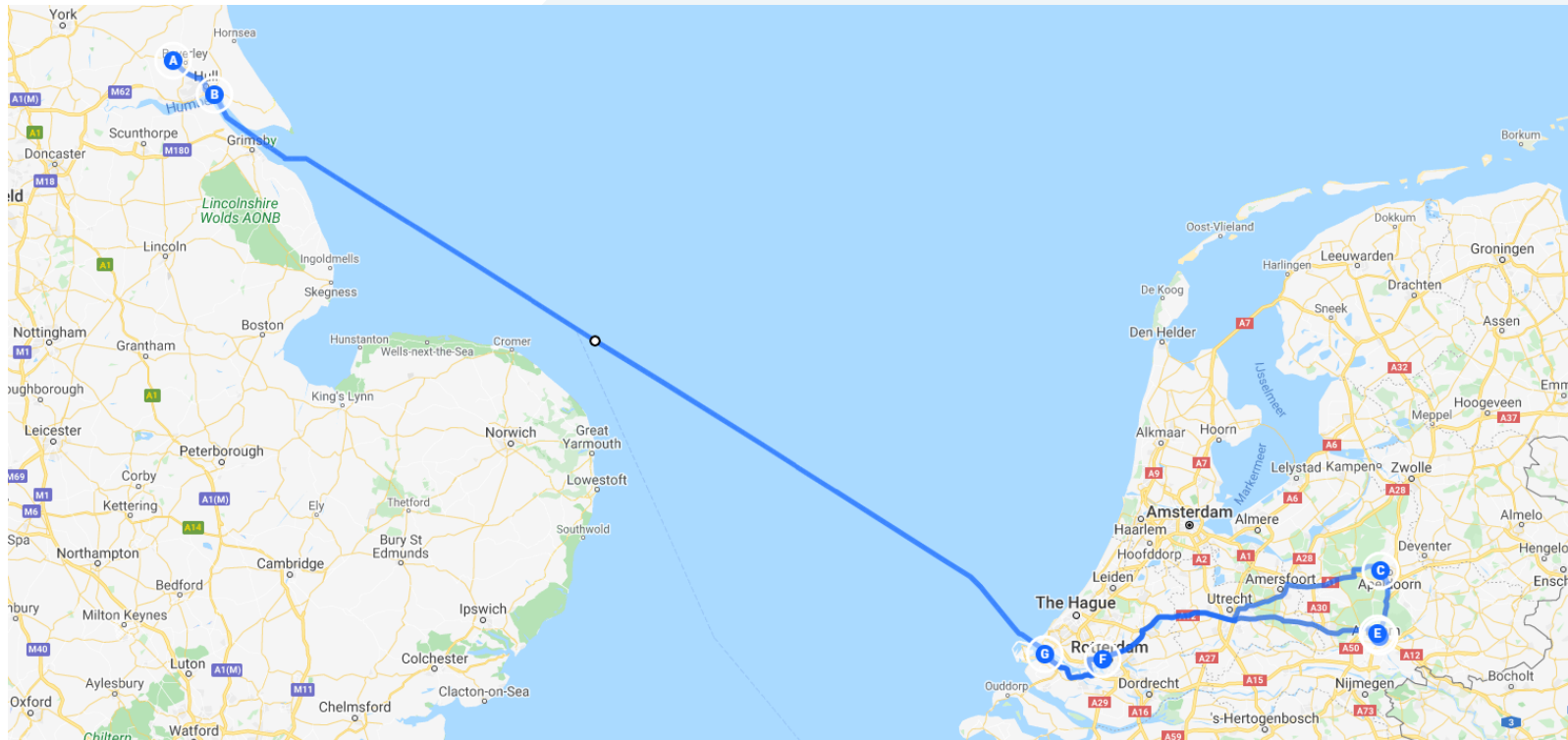

Apenheul Primate Park

- Their principle is simple: people enjoy animals more when they are having fun. The animals must be able to go their own way and be themselves. So no monkeys in cages or behind bars, but in large, natural outdoor enclosures in wooded areas. You'll roam free with the primates in their forested areas. It's been like this since 1971, with a few stray monkeys and developed into a foundation in 1986 with the objective of nature education and conservation.

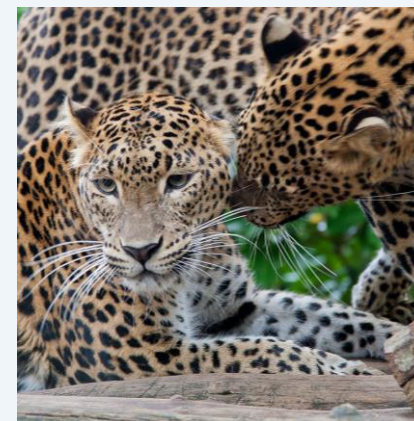

18.00 Evening meal served at the Youth Hostel

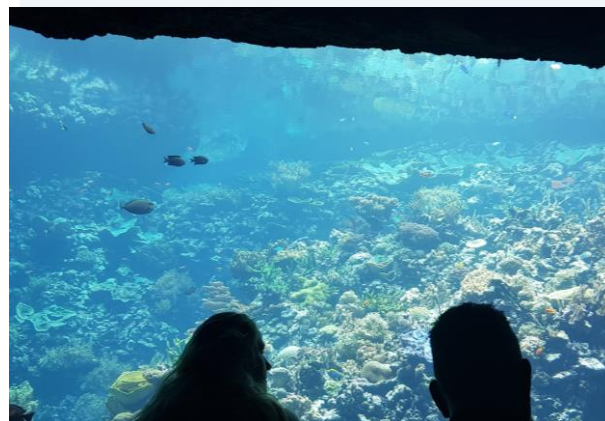


ABOUT THE PROJECT



Royal Burgers' Zoo

is a 45-hectare zoo in Arnhem, Netherlands and is one of the biggest zoos in the country. The Zoo prides itself on their environmental (eco) displays, where large scale natural habitats are recreated, rather than the traditional zoo enclosures. See indoor controlled bushlands and a central American desert, landscaped with rocks and vegetation. Observe the largest indoor mangrove swamp in the world and home to the Burgers Zoo manatees. It even boasts the largest living coral reef in Europe

- Overnight on Ferry with Dinner included

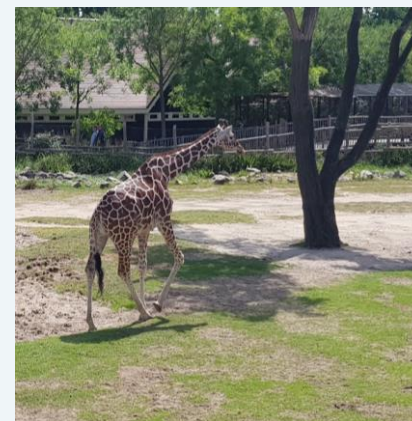


ABOUT THE PROJECT



Rotterdam Zoo

(Diergaarde Blijdorp), is a zoo located in the north western part of Rotterdam. It is one of the oldest zoos in the Netherlands, zoos are an important place to conduct research and Rotterdam zoo is no exception; they have a large number of research projects and in many cases, they work closely with different organisations including universities and research institutions. A number of breeding programmes are co-ordinated at the zoo.

Hints and Tips

- If you're a fussy/picky eater
 - bring snacks, purchase items at the ASDA stop, and purchase your main meal at the zoo during the day
- Bring a small overnight bag for the ferry
- There is no Wi-Fi in cabins whilst aboard the ferry, (only in public areas and at cost)
- Do not use mobile data on the ferry.
- Keep yourselves safe on the ferry.
- Pack a towel for the youth hostel.
- Card payments are accepted everywhere.

Insurance

Personal travel insurance is compulsory. Travel insurance does not need to be expensive and there are many good deals available for backpackers etc. Always be sure to check the insurance details to make sure you are covered for theft, loss, illness and injury. Check to see if your medical benefits are paid out as they incur or on your return home.

Passport Requirements

It can take up to 6 weeks to obtain a passport – remember to start this process in plenty of time.

Your passport needs to be valid for at least 3 months beyond intended stay and be no more than 10 years old.

Visa Requirements

A visa is not required for British Passport holders, all other nationalities should check the requirements via the website below, if required a visa can be obtained from the Kingdom of the Netherlands.
