Day 1 – 20th May 2026

07.30 Depart Duchy College to travel to SEA LIFE London Aquarium with a lunch stop on the way.

14.00 Arrive at SEA LIFE London Aquarium, home to over 500 species in 14 themed zones; including the UK's largest coral reef display.

16.00 Leave SEA LIFE London Aquarium.

17.00 Arrive at Camden Market for you to explore and purchase dinner from a range of outlets.

18.30 Depart Camden Market for your hotel.

18.45 Arrive at Travelodge London Farringdon for your overnight accommodation.

Day 2 – 21st May 2026

08.30 Your morning starts with a simple Breakfast provided at Travelodge London London Farringdon before departing at 9.30 for the Natural History Museum.
