Important Travel Advice

Names and spellings

It is crucial that the names printed on your documents match your passport. If there is a mistake this will need to be changed, otherwise you may be refused travel. Name changes are not permitted at the airport. Please be aware that some airlines do not include middle names, apostrophes or hyphens on eTickets. Please ensure you print off your eTicket before travel using a laptop or PC as it does not always view as you would expect when using an iPhone.

Passport expiry date

Your passport must be valid for at least 30 days beyond the intended return date to your country of origin. If you hold a passport other than a British Citizen passport, you should seek more specific advice from the embassy.

Passport copies

It is recommended that you take photocopies of your important documents and keep them in a separate place.
