Project Overview

Rugby is a growing sport in Ghana, fuelled by passion but limited by a lack of structure and funding at grassroots level, leaving many talented young players eager for the chance to develop. This rugby coaching volunteer project in Accra allows you to play a role in shaping the future of the sport by working in both local schools and at the Accra Rugby Club (ARC). You'll introduce rugby to children aged 12–16, many of whom will be experiencing the game for the first time, delivering structured sessions through PE lessons and after-school clubs while identifying the most committed and promising players. You will have the opportunity to further develop these talented players at ARC, where volunteers may assist with advanced coaching focused on technical skills such as scrummaging, mauls and kicking. In addition to coaching, you'll have the unique opportunity to train and potentially play alongside senior ARC players, building strong cultural connections and gaining an authentic insight into the competitive and social side of West African rugby.
