Swimming in South Africa tells a tale of two sides. The first sees the country as a powerful and successful nation, claiming victory and world records throughout Africa and on the international circuit. From Olympic gold medallists to world record breakers, the South African swim team is clearly a force to be reckoned with. The other side of the sport tells a different story. Over 70% of the nation has little or no swimming ability and over 1000 drownings occur each year. This swimming volunteer project places you at the heart of the national Learn-to-Swim campaign, where your time and energy can genuinely save lives. Working alongside qualified local instructors, you'll help children from township communities build confidence in the water, learn essential life-saving skills and, in some cases, develop their swimming ability further. Whether you're introducing a child to the pool for the very first time or supporting more experienced swimmers, your role will be hands-on, rewarding and deeply meaningful, leaving a lasting impact that extends far beyond the pool.
