As a volunteer tennis coach, you will work with children aged 6 to 11 in schools and community programmes, introducing them to tennis through fun, engaging sessions that build skills, confidence, and a love for the game, while also supporting the Junior Tennis Initiative by coaching talented young players alongside local coaches to prepare for upcoming matches and tournaments. Your role will be flexible, taking the lead in grassroots sessions while gradually taking on more responsibility at the National Tennis Centre, and working closely with local coaches to pass on techniques and ideas that will keep the programmes thriving. Alongside your coaching, you will have access to the state-of-the-art courts and can even arrange matches against local players to test your own skills, making this placement a perfect mix of impact, skill development, and immersive sporting experience in beautiful St Lucia.
