Tennis in South Africa has long been seen as an elite sport, yet across the townships there is a huge, untapped passion for the game among young people who lack access to courts, equipment and coaching. This tennis volunteer placement gives you the chance to change that. Working alongside local organisations supported by the Roger Federer Foundation, you'll help bring structured, enjoyable tennis to schools and township communities around Port Elizabeth. As a volunteer coach, you'll run training sessions, organise matches and tournaments, and introduce the fundamentals of the game in a fun and supportive environment. The rewards are great because the raw tennis talent is often there, but the understanding of the basic techniques and rules are often lacking. With guidance from the in-country team, you'll build strong relationships, grow your own coaching confidence and help young players experience tennis as a source of enjoyment, teamwork and opportunity - proving that the sport truly is for everyone.
